In this issue, we continue our story about prominent Ukrainians who have shaped the nation's cultural and intellectual identity. Today, we feature [Ahatanhel Krymskyi — a brilliant orientalist, linguist, and historian fluent in over 60 languages](#), and a founding member of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine (1918). He authored over 1,000 works on the cultures and religions of the Near and Middle East. In recognition of his legacy, a street in Ankara, Türkiye, is named in his honor. Like many Ukrainians, he was arrested and killed by the Soviet regime as a so-called nationalist.
