Home and Frontline

- [Total Russian combat losses since February 24, 2022, to 05 September 2025](#): in personnel – 1,086,220, tanks – 11,159, ACV – 23,243, artillery system – 32,435.
- [2,888 enemy targets](#) have been destroyed by units of the Unmanned Systems Forces since the beginning of September.
- On 4 September, [Russian forces deliberately targeted a demining mission](#) run by the Danish Refugee Council near Chernihiv.
- On 2 September, [Ukraine was attacked by Russia using 526 aerial weapons](#), included more than 500 strike drones and 24 missiles.
- Units of the [Defense Intelligence of Ukraine \(DIU\) attacked Russian forces](#) with drones at an airbase near temporarily occupied Simferopol and Sevastopol in Crimea.
- Ukrainian farmers have harvested nearly [28.8 million tonnes of grain crops](#).
